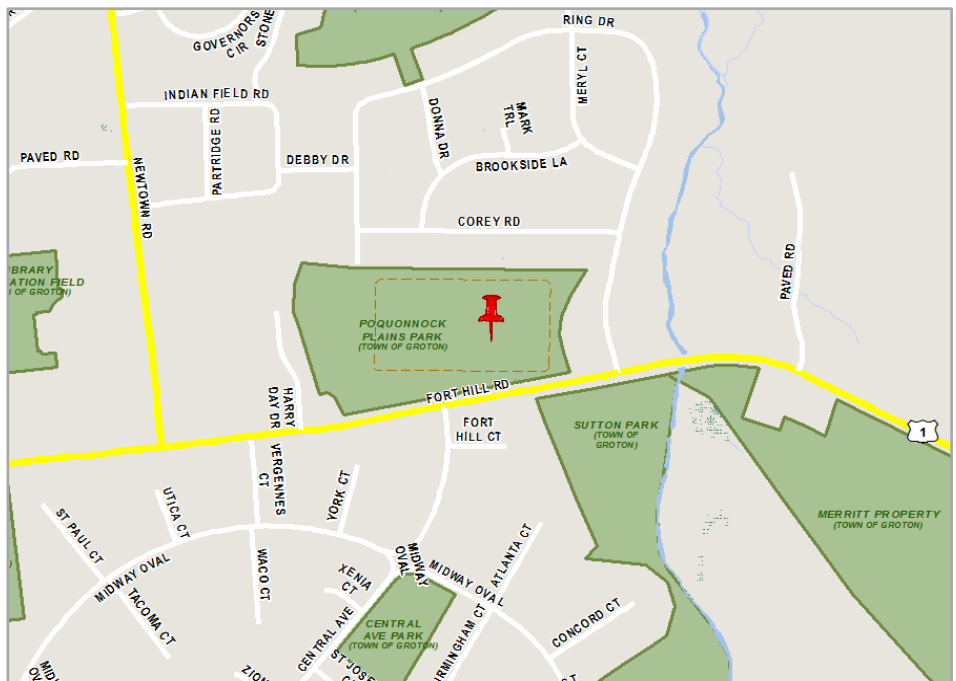

DIRECTIONS:

From Groton: Route 1 towards Mystic, 400' past the intersection of Route 117, Poquonnock Plains Park is on the left.

From Mystic / I-95 N & S: I-95 to Exit 88, south on Route 117 to end, left onto Route 1, Poquonnock Plains Park is 400' on the left.



Park Information:

Poquonnock Plains Park, 150 Fort Hill Rd, is a 15 acre property located in the center of Groton; it was dedicated on June 20, 1998. The park features three multi-purpose athletic fields, a one-half mile stone dust track for walking/jogging, and the Tercentennial Legacy Playground, which was dedicated on October 11, 2008. The playground is different from others in the community in that it is fully inclusive. The design, equipment, and location promote opportunities for people of varying abilities, ages, and generations to be involved with each other. Poquonnock Plains Park is home to many High School Sports and Groton Youth Football.
