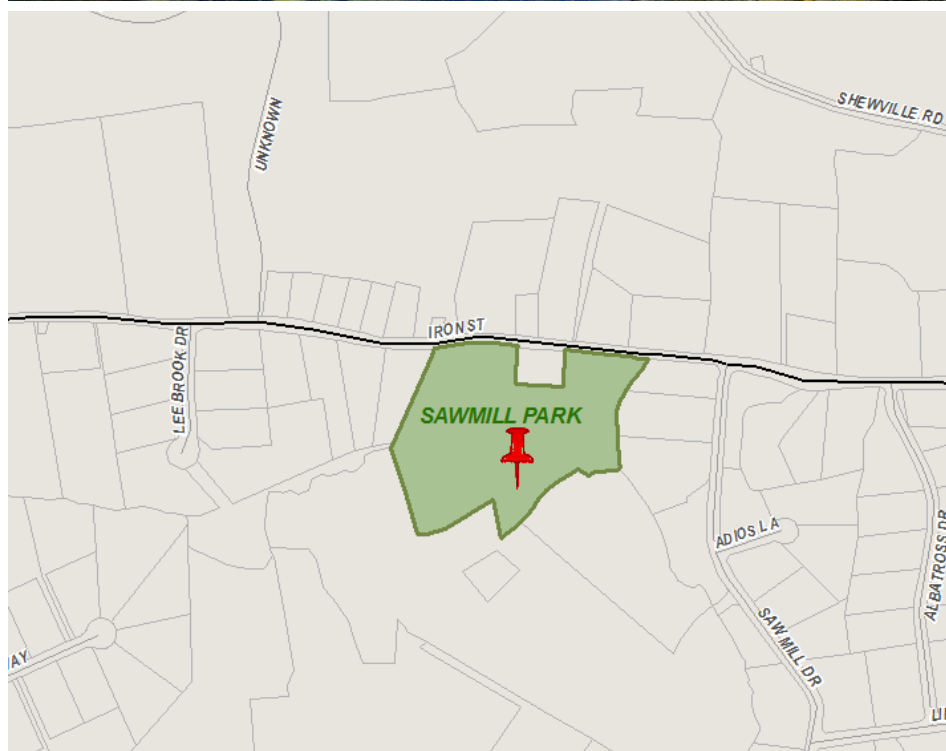

From I-95 S Take I-95 S to Mystic St. Take exit 89 from I-95 S, Turn right onto Mystic St, Continue onto Cow Hill Rd, Continue onto Pumpkin Hill Rd, Turn left onto Gallup Hill Rd, Continue straight onto Spicer Hill Rd, Turn right onto CT-214 E

From I-95 N Take I-95 S to Mystic St. Take exit 89 from I-95 S, Turn left onto Mystic St, Continue onto Cow Hill Rd, Continue onto Pumpkin Hill Rd, Turn left onto Gallup Hill Rd, Continue straight onto Spicer Hill Rd, Turn right onto CT-214 E



Park Information:

This historic site is located at 172 Iron Street (Route 214). The historic Ledyard Up-Down Sawmill is the original water-powered sash sawmill located on the original site on Lee's Brook in Ledyard. Restored to operating condition in the 1970's and now staffed by volunteers, the mill is open to the public for sawing demonstrations on Saturday afternoons in the spring and fall. There is no admission charge. The mill buildings and property are owned by the town of Ledyard, CT, and administered by the Ledyard Historic District Commission. Leyardsawmill.org was created by and maintained by volunteers for the purpose of education and publicizing the Ledyard Up-Down sawmill and historic sawmill technology. This site also contains picnic areas, swings, and park benches.
