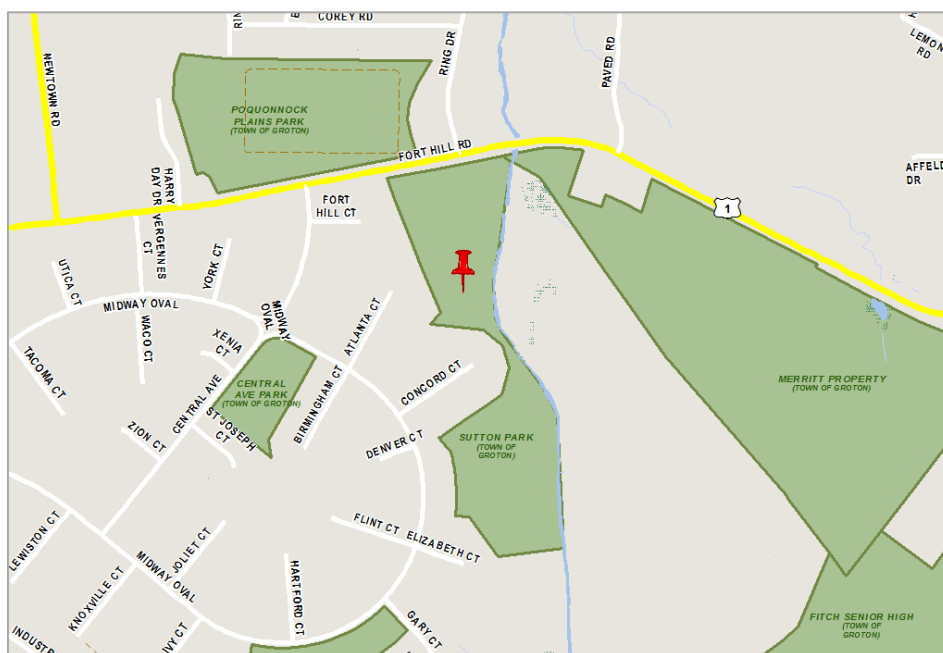

DIRECTIONS:

From Groton: Route 1 towards Mystic, past the intersection of Route 117, at bottom of hill, Sutton Park and Skate Park are on the right. Bear to the right once in the entrance, softball fields are to the back of the complex.

From Mystic / I-95 N & S: I-95 to Exit 88, south on Route 117 to end, left onto Route 1, at bottom of hill, Sutton Park and Skate Park are on the right. Bear to the right once in the entrance, softball fields are to the back of the complex.

The Skate Park provides skateboarders and in-line skaters an excellent year-round alternative to street skating. Groton's Skate Park in Sutton Park is the premier facility in Connecticut! The Park is open sunrise to sunset.

Sutton Park consists of two principle areas: the north area containing the skatepark, two picnic shelters, basketball court and playground. The basketball court is lit allowing play at night. The south area contains a softball field and little league field.
