DIRECTIONS:

I-95 N & S: I-95 to Exit 89, go south on Allyn Street; stay on Allyn as it crosses Route 1, then becomes West Mystic Avenue. Turn right onto Route 215 (Noank Road); travel about one mile. Destination will be on the left.



Park Information:

On the east side of Noank Road (Rte. 215) across from Beebe Pond Park. Approximately 0.3 mile of trails beginning behind the grey gate. Mature, mixed hardwood forest, with a narrow tidal marsh extending 900 feet along the edge of Beebe Cove. Town's end is owned by Avalonia Land Conservancy, whose mission is to preserve natural habitats in southeaster CT.

Towns End is part of the X-Town Trail, a six mile trail that connects Bluff Point State Park to Towns End. For a map of the trails in the Towns End click on the Groton Trails logo to the left.
