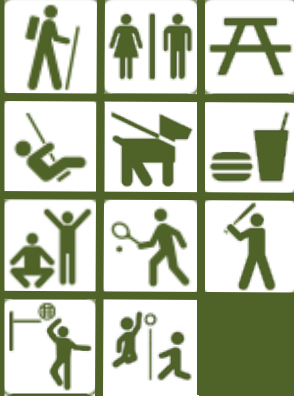


# WASHINGTON PARK

155 MERIDIAN STREET, GROTON CT 06340

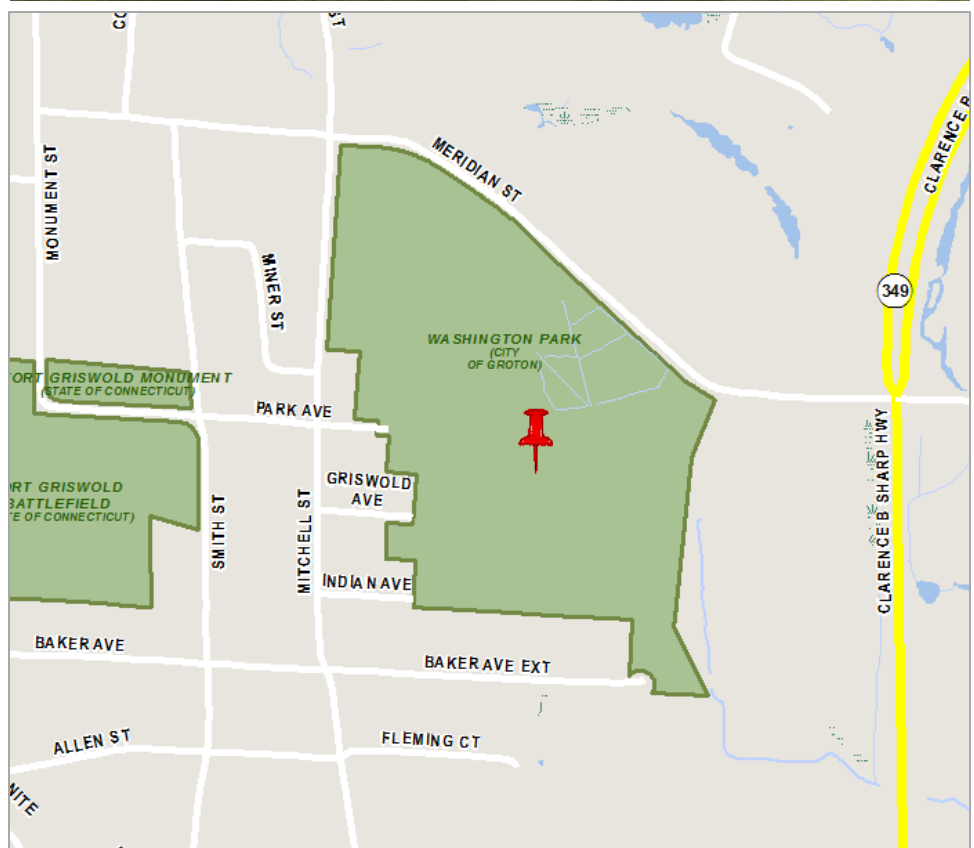


**OWNER:** City of Groton

## DIRECTIONS:

From New London/Waterford: Take 95N to exit 85 toward Thames St/Downtown Groton. Take the first right exit off ramp and follow to stop light. Go straight through stop light on to North Street. At second light, turn left on to Meridian Street. Park will be on your right.

From Mystic: Take 95S to exit 87 (Clarence B Sharp Hwy – land hand exit). Stay in the right lane off exit, at first traffic light take a right on to Meridian Street. The park will be on your left.



## Park Information:

Washington Park is on Meridian Street next to the Groton Municipal Building (155 Meridian Street, Groton, CT 06340). The 32.9-acre park includes three baseball fields, two softball fields, playground equipment, tennis courts, outdoor fitness circuit, volleyball area, basketball hoops and outdoor pavilions. The park also features a workers' memorial, honoring those who have died or been injured on the job. George Marquardt donated the land for Washington Park on Dec. 31, 1931 to residents of the City of Groton. It provides a recreational and family atmosphere we are proud of.
