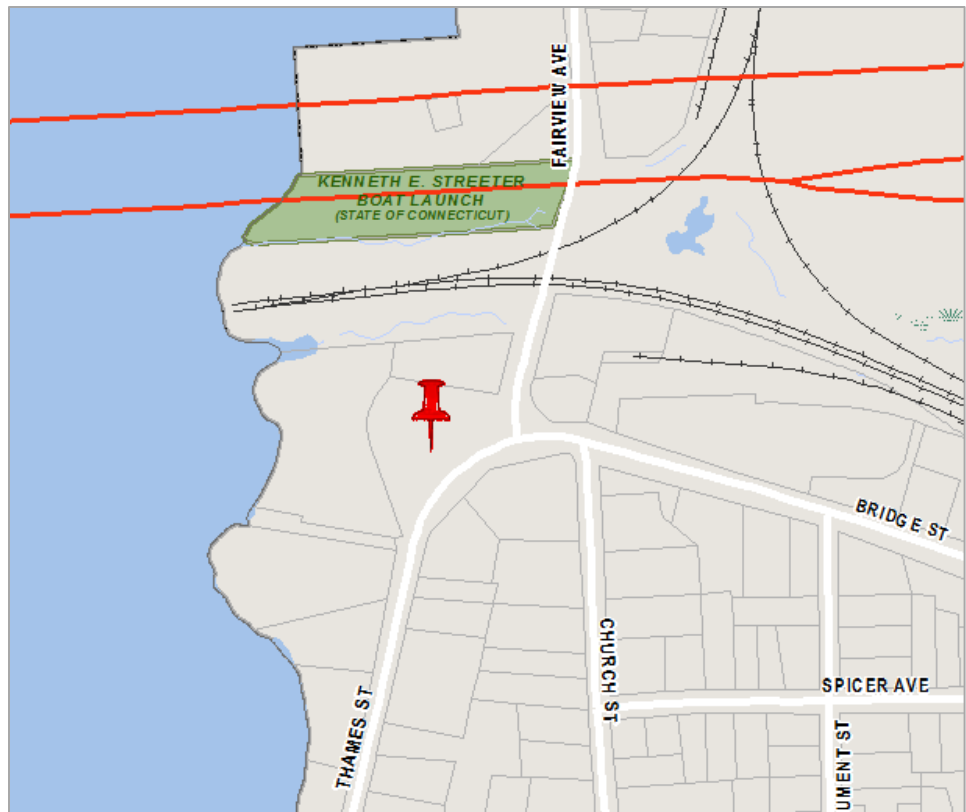

HOURS: Dawn to Dusk

DIRECTIONS:

From I-95 N, Use the right lane to take exit 85 for US-1 N toward Thames St/Downtown Groton, Keep right, follow signs for Thames Street and merge onto Bridge St, Turn right to stay on Bridge St, Destination will be on the left.

From I-95 S, Use the 2nd from the left lane to take exit 87 for CT-349/Clarence B. Sharp Hwy toward US-1 N, Continue onto CT-349 S/Clarence B Sharp Hwy, Take the Bridge St exit toward US-1/Downtown/Groton, Turn left onto Bridge St, Turn right to stay on Bridge St, Destination will be on the left.



Park Information:

Dedicated to the 3,617 courageous submariners who lost their lives during WWII. There are 52 engraved granite stones around the concrete walkways honoring each of the 52 U.S. Submarines lost in World War II.

National Memorial (East) displays an actual conning tower of a WWII submarine.

The Memorial is located on Bridge Street in Groton between the intersections of Fairview Avenue and Thames Street.
